NEWS BRIEFS

IMPORTANT HAPPENINGS AT A GLANCE

UNG to Probe Iran Deal—New York—By a vote of 2 to 1 the United Nations security council voted Tuesday to investigate the agreement under which soviet troops withdrew from Iranian soil. Russia and Poland alone voted against investigating the agreement.

Caterpillar To Double Plant—The Caterpillar Tractor company announced a proposed plant expansion program Tuesday that will add almost 40 acres or almost 60 per cent to the East Peoria factory. The program is to be developed in the next two years and is expected to cost \$50,000,000. The principal expansion will be for the construction of diesel engines.

Miners to Strike Sunday—Washington, D. C.—A strike of soft coal miners all over the country has been called for midnight Sunday by John L. Lewis. The stoppage is expected to throw heavily 400,000 soft coal miners out of work and will give another setback to industry which is slowly recovering from war's aftermath of strikes.

Grand Coulee Dam the Biggest—Seattle, Wash.—A comparison of figures shows that the Grand Coulee dam on the Columbia river is the largest masonry structure ever erected by man. The dam is seven times as large as the Cheops pyramid in Europe. Its spillway can form a waterfall five times the average flow of Niagara and three times as high.

96,000 Vets Get GI Loans—Washington, D. C.—Loans under the GI Bill of Rights to buy homes, farms and businesses have been received by more than 96,000 veterans, the Veterans administration announced. The VA reported that in 2,053 cases where the asking price was found to be out of line with the appraised value it had negotiated with property owners to secure reductions amounting to nearly \$700,000.

Hutchins Fears U. S. Blunders—Los Angeles—Our statesmen are blundering into a war with Russia because of their prejudices, ineptness or inability to cope with the problems of an atomic age, Robert M. Hutchins, chancellor of the University of Chicago, declared here in a talk before the Modern Forum. Hutchins declared that an atomic war is world suicide and no one can win.

Eat Evon for Wedded Bliss—Springfield, Ill.—Wedded happiness can be fostered by three well-balanced meals a day instead of the prevailing customs of having light breakfasts and luncheons and then gorging on a heavy dinner, according to Dr. Janis Smith, head of the nutrition department of the University of Illinois. A heavy dinner makes hubby drowsy and that's no good for the family, Dr. Smith said.
