## Says Parker

### Sapped' Her

Harold Parker, proprietor of Harold's Club, 103 N. E. Washington St., was arrested and released on \$400 bond Saturday on a charge of assault and battery.

The warrant was signed by Cathleen Dunlap and Sarah Mae Monroe, waitresses at Parker's night club. Parker allegedly hit the Monroe woman with a blackjack after an argument over a customer's change.

The Monroe woman told police that the beating took place after she had rectified a \$1 mistake in change with the customer. She said that Parker then came up and hit her. She hit him back and he allegedly struck her on the head with the blackjack.

The Dunlap woman said that when she came to the aid of the other waitress, a bouncer employed by Parker threatened her with a gun and hit her in the mouth with a blackjack. No charges were filed against the bouncer.

Parker is scheduled to appear in Police Magistrate Charles Iben's court on July 30 at 9 a.m.
