5 Defendants

Five persons, two men and three women, have been named in prostitution charges by city and state police who arrested them Friday night at 409 Aiken Ave. ~~PRYOR AND~~

Three of the arrested had escaped arrest Thursday night during a prostitution raid at the same Aiken avenue address, state police said.

They were identified ^{as Le Roy Pryor, alias Bucky Carter,} as Le Roy Pryor, alias Bucky Carter, 50, who is charged with being keeper of a house of prostitution and resisting arrest; John Martinez, 44, charged with soliciting for prostitution and resisting arrest; and Joyce Blair, 20, charged with being an inmate and resisting arrest.

Two women who police said were in the Aiken avenue house at the time of the arrests Friday night were charged as inmates of a house of prostitution. They are Ann (Pryor) and Toni Hunt, 29.

A STATE TROOPER reported he was admitted to the Aiken avenue address Thursday night by Martinez and was propositioned by a girl later identified as Donna E. Maxfield, 21.

The trooper said after money was exchanged and he identified himself as a policeman, several people grabbed the girl and fled.

THE MAXFIELD woman surrendered at the Peoria police station yesterday and was served with warrants charging her with resisting arrest and being an inmate.

Martinez, the Pryors, and the Hunt, Blair, and Maxfield women all have been released on bonds pending court hearings
