A mixed group of CORE members visited the "Cafeteria" and "Galley" at Bishop's, and were served without any difficulty. In the past, however, the manager would serve them (after they tried to be served in the "Galley" upstairs (Cafeteria)). The manager refused to serve them in the "Galley" as a mixed group or negro individuals. The hostesses and the manager were neither present. We feel there has been a change in management or change in the manager's policy.

A mixed group of CORE members visited the "Pantry", whose owner is a Jew, but were refused by the manager (white). A committee has tried to contact the owner, but without much success.

CORE plans a consultation with the owner in regard to his policy. If it is his policy to discriminate, we plan to have a sit-down strike.

Other eating places are being attacked in the same manner.

CORE president asked the principal and music teacher ~~of the~~ ^{of the} High School, to modify a "Minister" they planned to give. She asked to modify blackface, pig-tails, dialect and words such as "darker" and "pickaninny".

She was referred to the Superintendent of School, Dr. Davis, who wanted to know if it was an isolated idea or nation-wide. The president returned with mothers and citizens who tried to explain the

hindrance of such a plan, but still the Superintendent wanted to know "if it was nation-wide; what did N.A.A.C.P. think of it; why not take it to them?"

A Committee worked with the N.A.A.C.P. and contacted outside interested groups and organizations, who in turn sent telegrams and letters of protest.

The ~~Ministral~~ was changed to a very nice musical. The minister, however, included several negroes.

C.O.R.T. is planning a meet for all C.O.R.T. or similar groups near Peoria to be held here in the near future. Which will be in the fall.

C.O.R.T. has had two money raising programs; a "Carnival" and a "Hayride".

C.O.R.T. is planning to attack the swimming problem here. Negroes are allowed to swim only one day (Friday) a week. The Y.M.C.A. has a discriminatory policy in regard to swimming, etc.
