COMPLAINT FOR DIVORCE

Now comes the Plaintiff, RICHARD F. PRYOR, by his attorney, Harold N. O'Hara, and complaining of the Defendant, PATRICIA B. PRYOR, says:

1. That the Plaintiff and the Defendant are now, and for more than one year last past have been residents of the City of Peoria, County of Peoria and State of Illinois.

2. That on June 11, 1961, Plaintiff was duly and legally married to PATRICIA B. PRYOR, the defendant herein, and ever since Plaintiff and Defendant have been and are now husband and wife; and at all times during said marriage Plaintiff has demeaned himself as a kind, true and affectionate husband.

3. That Plaintiff and Defendant lived and cohabited together as husband and wife until on or about the 1st day of Sept-
Tempe 1961.

4. That during the time said Plaintiff and Defendant lived and cohabited together as husband and wife, one child was born to this marriage, namely RICHARD F. PRYOR, JR., who is now three years of age.

5. That the defendant is not a fit person to have the care, custody, control and control of the education of the child of the

parties hereto.

6. That the parties own no real estate or other property jointly.

7. That on or about the 25th day of March 1964, and at various other times and places since the said marriage, Defendant in utter disregard and in violation of her marriage duties and obligations, committed adultery and had carnal knowledge with a certain male person whose name is not definitely known, and the said Plaintiff is informed and believes that said Defendant has at divers other times and places unknown to the Plaintiff, committed adultery with divers other unknown male persons.

8. That on becoming acquainted with the above facts, Plaintiff left said Defendant and has since refused to live and cohabit with her.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff prays judgment that the said marriage between the Plaintiff and the Defendant may be dissolved and a divorce from the bonds of matrimony be decreed by this Court according to the statute in such cases made and provided; and that the Plaintiff may have such other and further relief as may be just and equitable.
