144-6-91 Communication signed by Mayor E. N. Woodruff stating last week a conference was held between a representative of the State Department of Public Health, Army Officials and the Mayor in an effort to see what steps should be taken to solve the social problem now existing in City of Peoria and further stating the State Department of Public Health says there is an opportunity to secure a sufficient amount of the drug Penicillin to take care of the needs of City of Peoria until January 1, 1943 and urging City Council appropriate the sum of \$1,000.00 to pay for Penicillin needed to carry out the experiment proposed and submitting copy of ordinance prepared for appropriation of necessary funds to carry out purposes recommended.

Alderman Kumpf moved same be referred to the Health and Finance Committees.
